**Capacity: 20 participants**

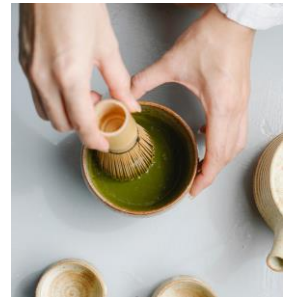
